I missed hearing parents talk about how much their child grew through the experiences of doing things that were outside of their comfort zone yet felt so safe taking that leap. I missed seeing our students coming together, laughing, having fun together, and creating beautiful art. These are some of the things that I realized I have taken for granted over the years. I look forward to embracing these magical moments once we are able to return to some form of normalcy.

We are busily putting plans in place for 2021. We look forward to creating safe opportunities for our students and audiences throughout the new year. We will be starting by offering virtual arts programming in January, all the way through providing a full roster of face to face classes and performance opportunities throughout the summer. We have a number of concerts on the calendar for the summer of 2021, and we hope our community will be able to safely come together, once again, to experience and enjoy live entertainment in our beautiful Bluestem amphitheater.

As we near year end, we ask you to consider supporting the important work of Trollwood. Our budgets depend, in part, upon gate receipts, concession sales, registration fees, rental income, and donations. As you can imagine, this has been a tough year financially for Trollwood Performing Arts School.
